how historical preservation efforts to protect architectural monuments arose in the twentieth century the twentieth century was highly destructive but from its landscapes of ruins was born a new architectural type the cultural monument in the wake of world war i an international movement arose which aimed to protect architectural monuments in large numbers and regardless of style hoping not only to keep them safe from future conflicts but also to make them worthy of protection from more quotidian forms of destruction an evolving group including architects intellectuals art historians archaeologists curators and lawyers grew out of the new diplomacy of the league of nations during and after world war ii it became affiliated with the allied military government and was eventually absorbed by the un as unesco by the 1970s this organization had begun granting world heritage status to a global register of significant sites from buildings to bridges shrines to city centers ruins to colossi examining key episodes in the history of this preservation effort including projects for the parthenon the cathedral of st lô the temples of abu simbel and the bamyian buddahs lucia allais demonstrates how the group deployed the notion of culture to shape architectural sites and how architecture in turn shaped the very idea of global culture designs of destruction emphasizes how the technical project of ensuring various buildings longevity jolted preservation into establishing a transnational set of codes values and practices at the same time this paradoxically helped integrate technologies of destruction from bombs to bulldozers into cultural governance designs of destruction not only offers a fascinating narrative of cultural diplomacy based on extensive archival findings it also contributes an important new chapter in the intellectual history of modernity by showing the manifold ways architectural form is charged with concretizing abstract ideas and ideals even in its destruction

canadian born flying ace raymond collishaw 1893 1976 served in britain s air forces for twenty eight years as a pilot in world war i he was credited with sixty one confirmed kills on the western front when world war ii began in 1939 air commodore collishaw commanded a royal air force group in egypt it was in egypt and libya in 1940 41 during the britain s western desert campaign that he demonstrated the tenets of an effective air ground cooperation system flying to victory examines raymond collishaw s contribution to

the british system of tactical air support a pattern of operations that eventually became standard in the allied air forces and proved to be a key factor in the allied victory the british army and royal air force entered the war with conflicting views on the issue of air support that hindered the success of early operations it was only after the chastening failure of operation battleaxe in june 1941 fought according to army doctrine that winston churchill shifted strategy on the direction of future air campaigns ultimately endorsing the raf s view of mission and target selection this view adopted principles of air ground cooperation that collishaw had demonstrated in combat author mike bechthold traces the emergence of this strategy in the raf air campaign in operation compass the first british offensive in the western desert in which air commodore collishaw s small force overwhelmed its italian counterpart and disrupted enemy logistics flying to victory details the experiences that prepared collishaw so well for this campaign and that taught him much about the application of air power especially how to work effectively with the army and royal navy as bechthold shows these lessons learned altered the allied approach to tactical air support and ultimately changed the course of the second world war

the functions of staff officers in u s military history have been largely ignored by historians who have preferred to focus on the role of the combat officer this examination of the career of general walter bedell smith chief of staff to general dwight d eisenhower and his valuable contribution to allied success represents an effort to fill a void in the current historiography of u s participation in europe in world war ii while specifically looking at smith s military career from his entry into the indiana national guard on his sixteenth birthday to his retirement from the u s army as a four star general 39 years later the volume is also a general investigation of the role of chief of staff and a critical study of the interwar u s army and its participation in the campaigns of the mediterranean and northwest europe during world war ii the institutional and attitudinal structure that produced the generation of american officers that commanded armies and manned higher headquarters is thoroughly evaluated in this volume d k r crosswell concludes that the normative influences of the army s advance schools conditioned the u s approach to war in europe eisenhower and smith s broad front strategy is seen as a product of their leavenworth educations smith s relationships with eisenhower and george c marshall are also seen as important formative influences despite a paucity of personal papers and no prior book on smith crosswell had access to a wealth of primary materials in the eisenhower library in abilene kansas and the resources of the combat studies library at the command and general staff college in leavenworth kansas substantial collections of materials at the federal research facilities in washington the u s army military history institute holdings in carlisle barracks pa and the george c marshall library in lexington va were consulted personal interviews with surviving world war ii officers and an examination of british sources were conducted to give the most complete picture of smith to date the chief of staff is divided into four major sections bedell smith and officership in the u s army 1917 1939 the towering figure george c marshall the first campaign the mediterranean northwest europe and an epilogue which covers smith s post army years the 14 chapters present smith as perhaps the best example of the world war ii military manager he emerges from these pages as a central figure of the period and his contributions within the allied sphere proved fundamental to eventual battlefield success seven maps of world war ii major theaters of operation from morocco to normandy and never before published archival photographs are included military history and world war ii buffs won t want to miss this splendid read which will also appeal to academic military historians libraries and research facilities as well as current and retired military officers the book is ideal supplemental reading for courses in u s military history
